- "Efforts to restore the American chestnut must involve traditional breeding, biotechnology, and biological control methods."
- BREAKOUT 2
- "The planting of Chinese chestnuts, as well as other non-native chestnut species, should be limited."
- "All we need to begin restoration is a disease-resistant American chestnut."
- "Public perception and regulatory challenges are important considerations in American chestnut restoration efforts."
